- a) under the age of 18 years,
- b) found by any court, in Canada or elsewhere, to be incapable of managing the individuals own affairs,
- c) an undischarged bankrupt, or
- d) convicted in or outside of British Columbia of an offence in connection with the promotion, formation or management of a corporation or unincorporated entity, or of an offence involving fraud, unless
 - i. the court orders otherwise,
 - ii. five years have elapsed since the last to occur of 2017-2018
 1. the expiration of the period set for suspension of the passing of sentence without a sentence having been passed,
 2. full payment of any fine imposed,
 3. the conclusion of the term of any imprisonment, and
 4. the conclusion of the term of any probation imposed, or
- e) a pardon was granted or issued or a record suspension was ordered under the Criminal Records Act Canada and the pardon or record suspension, as the case may be, has not been revoked or ceased to have effect.
